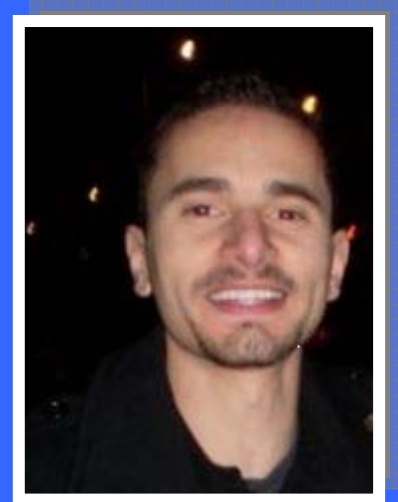


HUSEYIN NIZAM
