IMPORTANT NOTE: A Study Plan Checklist is an aid ONLY and should be used in conjunction with the program calendar; it is NOT a substitute for the calendar.

Minimum academic standing for BAS Specialized Honours degree: overall 5.0 [C+] gpa if less than 90 credits completed (including total number of transfer credits obtained); overall and ADMS gpa of 5.0 [C+] at and above 90 credits completed (including total number of transfer credits obtained); overall 5.0 and ADMS gpa of 5.5 [C+/B] at 120 credits completed or above (including total number of transfer credits obtained).

Residency requirement: At least 30 credits not used toward another academic program are to be taken at York University. 50% of credits towards the major must be taken in ADMS through York University.

Graduating with a BAS Honours degree: Students must pass at least 120 credits that meet degree and program requirements. The minimum cumulative grade point average must be at least 5.0 for all courses and 5.5 for major courses.

Failure to maintain minimum academic standing: Advising recommended

Students whose cumulative grade point average on at least 24 York credits is below 2.5 must withdraw for 12 months.

Students who have completed less than 90 credits who fall below the minimum cumulative grade point average of 5.0 will be placed on program warning and may continue in the 90 credit BAS bachelor degree only.

Students who have completed 90 credits with a cumulative grade point average below 5.0 and/or a major grade point average below 5.0 will be ineligible to proceed in honours or graduate. Additional 12 credits may be taken in subsequent sessions to raise the grade point average to meet program standards for a bachelor degree (12 new or repeated credits over 90, for the max. of 102 credits). Students may petition for an Honours waiver or to be allowed additional credits to graduate with the bachelor degree.

Students who have completed 120 credits or more with a cumulative grade point average of at least 5.0 and a major grade point average of at least 5.0 but below 5.5 are ineligible to graduate with Honours but may apply to graduate with the 90 credit BAS bachelor degree.

Students who have completed 120 credits or more with a cumulative grade point average below 5.0 or a major grade point average below 5.5 will be ineligible to proceed or graduate. Students may petition for an Honours waiver to be allowed additional credits to graduate with the honours degree.
